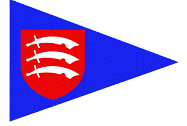


AYC Membership Notes



Please find below details of how to become a member at the Alexandra yacht club.

Route to membership

1, Select membership category

A, Family member

B, Single member

C, Friends of the AYC

2, If a jetty space is required, please indicate the type of craft on the application form.

3, If you wish to launch a craft from the Jetty but not store it at the jetty please indicate this on the application form.

4, Complete and submit your personal details and all relevant sections on application form via the website.

What will happen next.

Once your application has been received, A member of the committee will contact you to arrange an informal chat, in person or via the phone.

Once membership is accepted, (Usually within a month), you will need to,

- Pay fees via a link provided.

Once you have paid, you will receive a welcome letter, which will arrive by email.

You will also receive a welcome pack by email. This will include

- Events programme (if published for the year & Jetty Rules)
- 200 Club membership form (see website for more details)
- Facilities Information include padlock and door codes.
- You have the option to join our WhatsApp group

Membership Categories

Family Member (A)

Family membership is applicable to 1 or 2 adults and up to 2 cadets all living at the same address. Cadets in this category will be accepted up to the age of 18 and additional cadets within the family will be charged at £15 each.

Single Member (B)

An individual over the age of 18 at the time of application.

Any individual in full time education will be eligible for a 50% discount.

Any individual over 65 will be eligible for a 50% discount.

Friends of the AYC (C)

Any person wishing to support the club and be welcomed to social events run by the club.

Fees

Membership runs from 1 January to 31 December each year. Membership is due on 1 January.

New members will be liable to pay **one twelfth** of the annual subscription for each full month remaining in the year (Pro rata).

Commencing from the date of his/her application plus the one-off joining fee.

A Monthly Payment Option is available.

Jetty Fees are separate from Membership subscriptions and when your vessel is first placed on the Jetty the pro rata applies, following this the full annual fee must be paid when due with no refund should your vessel be removed mid year.

Membership and Jetty Fees

Membership

Category	Annual Fee	One off joining fee
Family Members	£140	£50
Single Member	£125	£50
Friends of AYC	£25	N/A

*Any individual Single member over 65 will be eligible for a 50% discount.

*Any individual Single member in full time education will be eligible for a 50% discount.

Additional Cadets £15 regardless of month of joining

Friends of AYC £25 regardless of month of joining

Jetty Fees

Type of Craft	Annual Jetty Fee
Sailing Boats	£100 (Jetty space + launch fee inclusive)
Kayak/Canoe	£55 (Jetty space + launch fee inclusive)
Stand up paddle board (SUP)	£40 (Rack space + launch fee inclusive)
Launching Only	£25 Any craft launched but not stored at the Jetty

Under the rules of the Alexandra Yacht Club membership if granted, is subject to a probationary period of 1 year.
